

Remote Volunteering Ideas

We will really miss having corporate volunteering teams on site at the moment but there are still some 'virtual skills volunteering' projects you could help with. So, if you still have time to give us, maybe you could consider:

- Donating a particular skill to help us in a future campaign. Whether that be design, social media planning, podcasting, or something else, we'd love to hear from you.
- Get a team of thinkers together and spend an afternoon working on solutions to one of our current business challenges or putting plans together for a future campaign
- Give back to the business community and create a **mentorship auction online**. You could offer business and leadership skills for an hour to your colleagues, clients or suppliers.
- Set up an 'Apprentice' style challenge where people work in teams to come up with fundraising ideas online. We could provide £10 seed funding per group for any set up costs and then see how much your team can make in a set time.
- Or organise a 'Dragons Den' where people work in groups to come up with a great fundraising idea. We will get a panel of judges to determine the best idea that the whole team work on together.
- Set up a virtual challenge. This could be number of steps, home cycling, how many blueberries you can eat or anything of your choice (so long as it can be done at home and sticking within Government guidelines). The [fundraising](#) platform is offering free support at the moment to charities so I can set something up for you.
- Learn a new skill – currently trending on social media this would be a great time to learn how to sign so why not join in with our signing challenge. We will give you all the resources you need to learn the alphabet and then ask you to upload a video of yourself finger signing your name.
- Spend some time running an online campaign to raise awareness of Seashell via your contacts and peers.
- Prepare a blog and publish around disability awareness, CSR, Seashell Trust or anything related.
- Spend an afternoon helping us research a future project. We'd send a full brief and would give you a clear list of outputs we'd need.
- Help us out with some grant writing – we'd give you a really clear brief.
- Maybe you can think of another way you could use your time to help us – we're always open to creative new ideas!
