# What to expect

**Seashell Deafblind (MSI) Intervenor is a five-day course and is delivered through both virtual and in-person sessions.**

The course meets the requirements of the NATSIP Intervenor standards and is quality endorsed by the Open College Network (OCN).

## Course content includes:

- Impact of deafblindness
- Visual and hearing impairment
- Sensory processing difficulties
- Tactile development and exploration
- Communication strategies (including tactile signing)
- Mobility and independent living skills
- Functional MSI curriculum and environments
- The role of the Intervenor

Attendees will be issued with a certificate of attendance on completion and will be regarded as a **'Trained MSI Intervenor'**

## We also offer specialised training in:

- Tactile communication.
- Habilitation (including sighted guide) and independent living skills.
- Deafblind (MSI) Awareness.
